WORDS OF ABSOLUTION AND FORGIVENESS

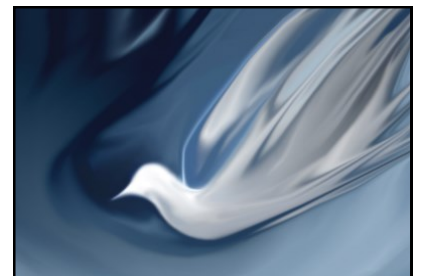

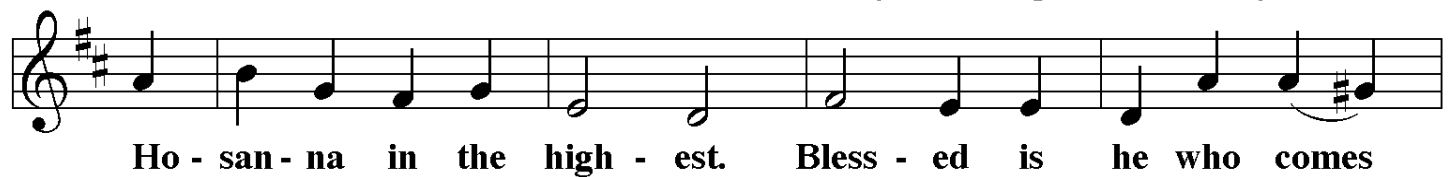
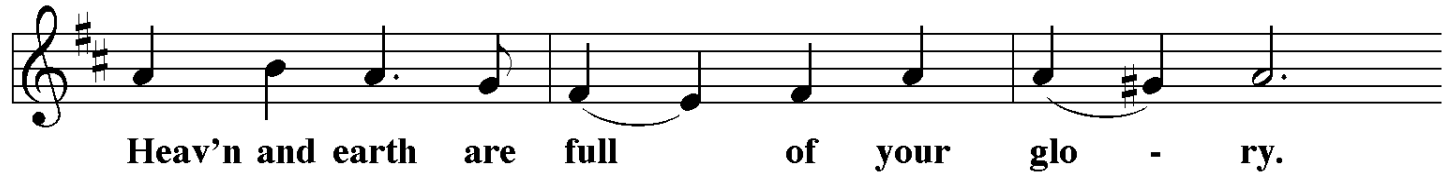
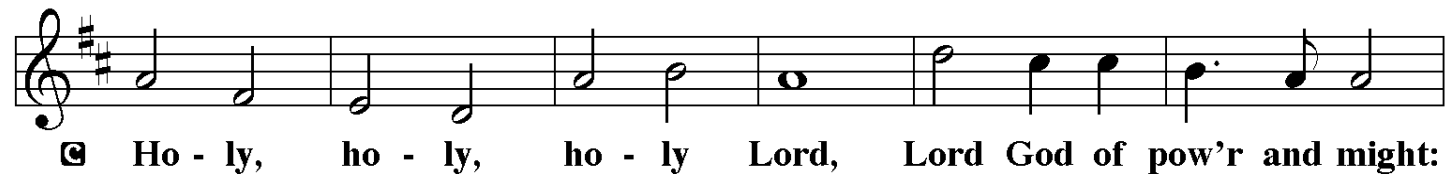
THE GREAT THANKSGIVING

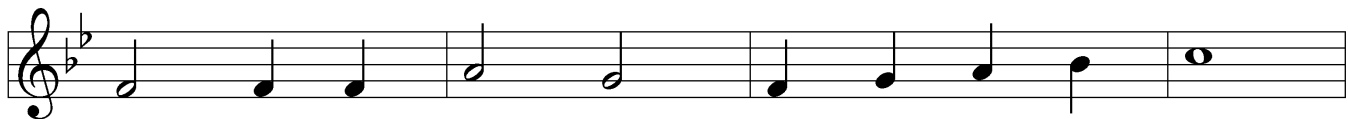

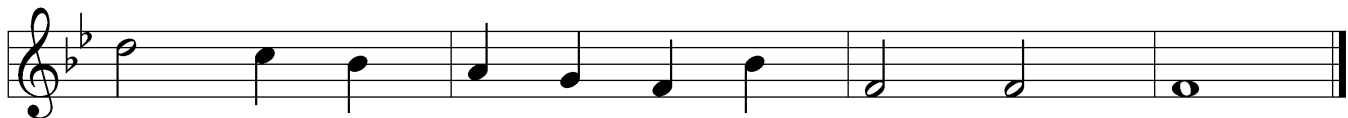
